- ❖ USAG named Joy the Junior Olympic Developmental Coach of the Year in 1991, the Trampoline Coach of the Year in 1997 and 1999 and she was the USAG Tumbling Coach of the Year in 1998.
- ❖ From 2001-2004, Joy was the National Tumbling & Trampoline Team Coordinator, in which she managed all coaching education, clinics, team camps, and training logs for the National Teams.
- ❖ Joy is a previous USA Team coach for several World Championships and has served as a World Age Group Coach in all events. She has produced numerous National Champions and Team members, including six-time Sr. National Trampoline Champion Ryan Weston.
